The idea

EP Tender is a range extending service for electric vehicles. With our modular approach, electric vehicles can satisfy both essential constraints: be affordable and versatile, with occasional long distance trip ability and peace of mind. Pure electric vehicles with a reasonable battery on daily usage, and plug-in hybrid for longer trips, by towing an energy module on demand. The Tenders are powered indifferently by gasoline, hydrogen, battery or inductive road as provided by the infrastructure and technology progress.

Furthermore the Tenders will themselves transit to H2, battery, and road inductive charging as early as possible.
